Foundry Day is a juried Arts and Crafts Festival presented by the Foundry Day Committee in conjunction with the Yellow Breeches Chapter of the Pennsylvania Guild of Craftsmen and the Boiling Springs Civic Association. Our **2020** show, the 34th in historic Boiling Springs, PA, will be held on **Saturday, June 6th from 9am to 4pm, rain or shine.**

**Booth Information**

- Foundry Day takes place outside on the narrow and uneven streets of Boiling Springs, PA. While some booth spaces are on level pavement, most require the back legs of the tent to be set up on the curb - bring levelers. A few spaces have shrubs or a fence immediately behind them; others have a "level" depth of 6' – 8' (but they will still accommodate a 10' x 10' pop-up tent). All booth spaces are at least 15' wide.
- The front line of the booth space will be marked with white dots. You may not have any items (table, stands, awnings, flags, etc.) beyond the front line marks (this ensures adequate emergency vehicle access).
- All tables must be covered to the ground. The sidewalk behind booths must be kept clear.
- All work exhibited must be original and attributable to the displaying exhibitor. The craftsman must be present at the show. No resale, commercially produced works, kits, patterns, or prefab forms are permitted. The Foundry Day Committee reserves the right to require the removal of any work deemed not meeting these requirements.
- Booth assignments are subject to last minute changes at the discretion of the Foundry Day Committee.
- Exhibitor parking is available for one vehicle per booth. Additional vehicles may be parked in designated overflow areas (we will notify you later). Overnight parking is not permitted. Electricity is not available.
- Booth fee checks are non-refundable upon acceptance to the show.

**Entry Procedure Requirements**

- Applicants must submit four digital images - three representative of the work to be exhibited and one of your booth set up. Images should be in JPG or JPEG format. Please ensure your photographs adequately reflect the quality and range of your work (we use your photos to compare the quality of your work against other submissions). You may submit your images on a CD, as attachments to an email, or ask us to use images that we already have on file (see application form).
- Deadline for application is February 10, 2020. A Jury session will take place in early March; applicants will be informed of the result of the Jury deliberations via email in mid March..
- Checks for those chosen to participate will be deposited immediately. Checks for those not accepted by the Jury will be returned in late March 2020. Applicants who are accepted in a standby status will be afforded the opportunity to remain on a waiting list; checks will not be deposited unless the applicant actually participates in Foundry Day, but will be retained until completion of the show in any case.
- Space assignment letters, detailed show instructions, and a parking pass will be sent by US Mail in early May 2020.
- All exhibitors are required to have a PA STATE SALES TAX NUMBER. If a tax number is needed, contact the PA Department of Revenue at (717) 787-1064 or at [www.revenue.state.pa.us](http://www.revenue.state.pa.us).
